• Faith and works are two sides of the same coin. You can't have one without the other.

KEY TRUTH

We are NOT saved by good works, but if we are saved we will DO good works as a consistent pattern of our lives as we follow Jesus.

"Faith and works should travel side by side, step answering to step, like the legs of men walking. First faith, and then works; and then faith again, and then works again—until they can scarcely distinguish which is the one and which is the other." William Booth

Two Foundational Verses:

1. Romans 3:28

"For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from observing the law (works). "

2. James 2:17

"Faith, by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead."

Credited: a legal or f______ term; means "to put to one's account"

"What then shall we say was gained by Abraham, our forefather according to the flesh? For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. For what does the Scriptures say? Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness." Romans 4: 1-3

"Your father Abraham rejoiced at the thought of seeing my day; he saw it and was glad." John 8:56

Abraham's Faith Evidenced by His Works: (Genesis 22)

"Faith alone justifies; but the faith that justifies is never alone." John Calvin
